#### WORLD DAY OF THE SICK SATURDAY FEB 11, 2012

#### ASH WEDNESDAY

**ASH WEDNESDAY** is the first day of Lent, the season of preparation for the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday.  
 Ash Wednesday falls 46 days before Easter. While Ash Wednesday is not a Holy Day of Obligation, Roman Catholics are encouraged to attend Mass on this day in order to mark the beginning of the Lenten Season.  
**THE ASHES THAT DISTRIBUTED** during Ash Wednesday Mass are made by burning the blessed palms that were distributed the previous year on Palm Sunday. After the priest blesses the ashes and sprinkles them with holy water the faithful come forward to receive them. The distribution of ashes reminds us of our own mortality and calls us to repentance.

**THE CHURCH EMPHASIZES** the penitential nature of Ash Wednesday by calling us to fast and abstain from meat. Catholics who are over the age of 18 and under the age of 60 are required to fast which means they can only eat one complete meal and two smaller ones during the day, with no food in between. Catholics over the age of 14 are required to refrain from eating any meat, or any food made with meat.

**FASTING AND ABSTINENCE** is not simply a form of penance, however; it is also a call for us to take stock of our spiritual lives. As Lent begins, let us set out specific goals we would like to reach before Easter and decide how we will pursue them.
